Access Group Announces New Law School Scholarship

Wilmington, DE: Access Group, the nonprofit graduate loan specialist, is asking law students throughout the country to videotape their worries for a chance at winning a \$10,000 law school scholarship to help them with their studies.

The company's One Less Worry law school scholarship contest requires students to get creative and submit an original video of up to 4 minutes showing what they worry about as law students. "Access Group has always looked for ways to educate and connect with students," says Jeff Hanson, director of borrower education services for Access Group. "With this contest, we're hoping to learn more about the concerns of law students so we can better focus our efforts and educational offerings to meet their needs," continues Hanson.

Submissions will be reviewed by Access Group and ten finalists will be selected. The finalists will be voted on by friends, family and the general public with the scholarship being awarded to the entry receiving the most votes.

Videos may be submitted through June 15, 2008. Finalists will be selected from all eligible entries received and voting will begin on July 1, 2008. The winner of the \$10,000 law school scholarship will be announced on August 1, 2008.

The contest is open to legal US residents 18 years of age or older who are law students (enrolled or matriculated as of August 1, 2008) and candidates for law degrees (JD or LLM) at tax exempt law schools in the United States (including the 50 states, District of Columbia and Puerto Rico).
